3 held for forging...

Rajasthan HC quashes rape FIRs filed by wives against hobbies

The Jaipur Bench of the Rajasthan High Court quashed two FIRs filed by wives against their husbands in separate cases, ruling that an adult wife cannot file a rape case against her husband in the existence of a valid marriage.

Justice Anoop Dhand observed, "It is precisely because of such cases that litigation becomes protracted,



cause of such cases that litigation becomes protracted,

leading to delays in the delivery of justice. Justice denied."

The ruling came in a case involving a Jaipur couple who entered into an inter-caste marriage when the woman was 18 years old.

After failing to secure a divorce from the Family Court, both parties approached the High Court.

During the proceedings, the wife lodged a rape complaint against her husband, alleging that he had blackmailed her into signing documents for registration of their marriage.

Observing that the marriage had been solemnised with mutual consent, the court said, "It appears that the FIR was lodged because

the inter-caste marriage did not have the approval of the family." The High Court subsequently quashed the FIR, holding that no rape case was made out.

In the second case, a young couple had married in 2020 according to Arya Samaj rites. The wife later filed one FIR alleging rape and another alleging dowry harassment against her husband.

Noting that both FIRs arose from the same circumstances, the court observed, "An allegation of rape implies that the victim is not the wife. Conversely, a case of dowry harassment can only be registered by a person in the capacity of a wife."

The court further stated that contradictory FIRs amounting to abuse of the legal process could not be permitted.

OBC panel cleared for UP Panchayat elections

The Uttar Pradesh cabinet on Monday approved the formation of an Other Backward Classes (OBC) commission for conducting panchayat elections in the state.

The commission will determine reservation for OBCs in panchayat elections and only after submission of its report will the election process move forward.



The move follows a Feb 4, 2025 order of the Allahabad High Court directing the state government to constitute such a commission before conducting local body polls with OBC reservation.

The report and survey conducted by the commission will determine which panchayat seats across dif-

ferent regions will be reserved for OBC candidates, including seats for women and men, and which will remain unreserved.

The state government's decision is linked to the "triple test" formula laid down by the Supreme Court for granting OBC reservation in local body elections.

Officials said the formation of the commission was aimed at fulfilling mandatory legal requirements under the triple test. Without the commission's report, direct implementation of reservation could face legal challenges and potentially stall the elections.

Key accused in Bengal CM aide murder held by CBI

The CBI on Monday arrested Raj Kumar Singh, believed to be a key accused in the murder of West Bengal Chief Minister Suwendu Adhikari's aide Chandrakant Rath, officials said Monday.

Singh, who also goes by an alias of Raj Singh, was arrested from Muzaffarnagar in Uttar Pradesh by a team of CBI, they said. Rath, the personal assistant to Adhikari, was shot dead in Madhyamgram on May 6, two days after the declaration of the fiercely contested West Bengal As-

sembly poll results. The CBI has taken over the probe into Rath's murder from the West Bengal Police following a request from the state government.

The central agency has formed a seven-member special investigation team under a DIG of Special Crime from Delhi, comprising some

of the best investigators drawn from its various units, the officials said. Police said at least eight people were allegedly involved in the conspiracy.

AAP leader held in ED action

The Enforcement Directorate on Monday arrested Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader Deepak Singla in connection with an alleged multi-crore money laundering case arising out of a Rs 150 crore scam in the Oriental Bank of Commerce, officials said.

The arrest followed coordinated searches at multiple premises linked to Singla and several hawala operators across Delhi and Goa, they said.

The ED action triggered sharp reactions from AAP which defended Singla, labelling the arrest as "politically motivated". Senior party leaders including its convenor Arvind Kejriwal slammed the raids, accusing the central government of using federal agencies as a political tool ahead of Goa elections.

Singla, who previously contested as the AAP candidate from Delhi's Vishwas Nagar assembly seat, was taken into custody after the raids led to the alleged recovery of incriminating documents.

It is the second time in two years Singla has faced action by the federal agency. He was raided by the ED in 2024 too.

Woman's body found in trunk on train

A chilling murder case surfaced in Lucknow on Sunday after the chopped body of an unidentified woman was recovered from a trunk and bags abandoned inside the sleeper coach of the Chhapra-Gomti Nagar Express at Gomti Nagar railway station, triggering panic among passengers and railway authorities.

The gruesome discovery was made when cleaning staff entered sleeper coach S-1 after the train completed its journey from Bihar's Chhapra to Lucknow.

Railway workers noticed an unattended trunk and bag lying between seats. Suspicion grew after they spotted blood

stains on the luggage, following which the Government Railway Police (GRP) was alerted.

When the trunk was opened, officials found the torso of a woman inside. Her severed hands and legs were packed separately in polythene bags and hidden among clothes kept in another bag. Police said the body had been cut into several pieces in an apparent attempt to conceal the victim's identity and transport the remains unnoticed.

According to GRP officials, the woman is believed to be between 25 and 35 years old and the body appeared to be around two days old. Investigators suspect the victim was murdered after her throat was slit.
