Panel submits report, special session on Feb 20 to discuss Maratha quota

THE MAHARASHTRA State Backward Class Commission on Friday submitted a report on the social and educational backwardness of the Maratha community for which it had undertaken a survey of around 2.5 crore homes within a span of only nine days.

The report has not been made public, but sources said it has confirmed the social and educational backwardness of Marathas, and has put the onus on the state government to find a way to extend reservation to Marathas.

"We will be calling a special session of the legislature on February 20 to discuss the issue of Maratha reservation based on the report. We will first table it before the Cabinet. We are positive on this issue of giving reservation to Marathas without harming the reservation of OBCs," said Chief Minister Eknath Shinde.

In 2018, a commission headed by Justice (retired) M G Gaikwad had submitted a report on the backwardness of the Maratha community. Based on that report, the Maharashtra government had extended reservation to Marathas, which, however, did not pass the muster in the Supreme Court.

Maharashtra's main opposition Congress demanded to

make the report public immediately. "What is so secretive about it? The report should be made public. Also, the government need not wait for the special session of the legislature and should issue an ordinance immediately to ensure reservation to Marathas," said senior Congress leader and former Chief Minister Prithviraj Chavan.

Senior minister in the Maharashtra Cabinet and OBC leader Chhagan Bhujbal said he is not opposed to providing independent reservation to Marathas. "Our only demand is that Marathas be given the reservation without harming OBC reservation. If the commission can complete the survey of 2.5 crore families in a record nine days, then the same exercise can be extended for a few more days and caste census be completed as well," said Bhujbal.

Meanwhile, the CM on Friday said the reservation, which will be extended based on the commission's report, will not be applicable to those who have already acquired Kunbi (OBC) certificates.

Following the agitation by Jarange-Patil, the Maharashtra government had appointed a committee headed by Justice (retired) Sandeep Shinde to define the process to extend Kunbi certificates to Marathas in the Marathwada region. The scope was further extended to across the state. The government has

also issued the notification of draft amendment of rules for giving caste certificates by including the word sage-soyare (extended family), which has been opposed by OBC organisations.

The commission headed by Justice (retired) Sunil Shukre was tasked to prepare the report to ascertain the social and educational backwardness of Marathas, and terms of reference for which were sent to the commission on November 13, 2023 by CM Shinde. The survey was based on the questionnaire prepared by Pune's Gokhale Institute and covered only those within the open category.

The state government had issued a Government Resolution authorising district collectors to enrol as many personnel as available for the survey. "Talathi, police patil, kotalwals have been directed to work along with enumerators to collect the data," said the resolution.

The commission's former chairman Justice (retired) Anand Nirgude and two members namely Balaji Killariker and Laxman Hake have resigned from the panel. Killariker and Hake had submitted their resignations to protest against what they said the government dictating the terms of reference. Another member, judge (retired) Chandralal Meshram, was removed as the commission's member two days before the submission of the report.
