

Court permits foreign trip for suspect

Travelling abroad is an integral facet of Fundamental Rights, said a Delhi court, allowing a woman accused of money laundering to visit Thailand because of her children's ongoing summer vacations.

Vacation Judge Rajesh Malik was hearing the application of Reena Goel, an accused in the case in which shops in Delhi's Karol Bagh market area of a group company of Shree Raj Mahal Jewellers had been attached under the anti-money laundering law as part of an investigation into a multi-crore bank loan fraud.

According to the Enforcement Directorate, the properties belonged to Ginni Gold Private Limited and its directors-cum-promoters Ginni Devi and Reena Goel.

In her application, Goel had been granted bail in December 2025 with the condition that she could not leave the country without the court's prior permission. But she wished to travel to Thailand for her children's summer vacations from June 25 to July 2. In an order dated July 19, the court said it needed to balance the right of the accused to travel abroad against the grounds for refusing such permission.

"The primary and most compelling ground for denial would be credible apprehension that she will flee from justice. Such apprehension can either be shown from the evidence or it can be gathered by drawing inferences from the other facts," the court said.

It, however, said that the ED has not shown any evidence or facts to show that she may flee from justice.

"It is not the case that she is making investments in foreign countries to settle abroad. Mere being an accused does not suffice to stop her from travelling abroad.

Jamiat Ulema-e-Hind National President, Maulana Syed Arshad Madani, arrived in Kaliyar, a small town near Roorkee in Uttarakhand's Haridwar, and attended the meeting of the State Executive Committee as the chief guest has sparked a fresh controversy, saying that "in 1803, when the country was under colonial rule, a call for 'Jihad' was issued for the nation's freedom. Therefore to free the nation, it was must for all Muslims to wage Jihad (war)".

While addressing a large gathering on Tuesday of the Ulemas (Islamic scholars), 'Hafiz' (someone who has memorised the Quran), and members of the Muslim community on various issues of national importance, includ-

BJP slams Madani's remark

New Delhi: After Jamiat Ulema-e-Hind national president Maulana Syed Arshad Madani stated that "Jihad is every Muslim's right," BJP leaders on Wednesday criticised the remark, alleging that such statements are made periodically to promote a political agenda and provoke sections of the Muslim community.

Speaking to IANS, BJP leader Rohan Gupta said,

"Maulana Madani, every 10-15 days, makes some statement or warning to promote his politics and provoke Muslims. However, I believe the Muslim community has now understood this pattern and no longer gives much importance to such remarks. Sometimes he talks about jihad, and at other times about different issues, but Muslims in the country are receiving their rights as citizens of India."

Jihad is the duty of every Muslim. This is a movement that originated from the madrasas. Whoever does not know this is ignorant."

Highlighting the significance of Muslims and mosques in the struggle for country's Independence, the

Jamiat Ulema-e-Hind President remarked that the current Narendra Modi-led Union government is demolishing these very mosques.

"After Independence, those in power began to harm Muslims; successive governments kept the Muslim community entangled in riots and unrest, but the current government is opposed not only to Muslims but to Islam itself. Our religious sites are being razed with the help of bulldozers."

He said that Muslims have made a significant contribution to the country's Independence and its progress.

Maulana Madani remarked that the country can only function through love and harmony, yet today, mosques and madrasas are being demolished, and Muslims are falling victim to mob lynching.

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Rape convict escapes jail as cops watch reels

A jail inmate serving life sentence in the Central Jail of Bareilly escaped after scaling the walls of the prison complex while the guards watched reels on social media. He had been convicted for raping a child.

Eleven officials of the prison have now been suspended over the incident, the report said. Jailer Neeraj Kumar and Deputy Jailer Vandana Chowdhary were suspended by Director General (Prisons) PC Meena. Strong departmental action was recommended against senior jail superintend-

ent Avinash Gautam. Seven low-ranking jail staffers were also suspended following this major breach in the security of this jail in Meerut.

"Action has been taken against the personnel for dereliction of duty," the DG was quoted saying by ToI.

The convict, identified as 22-year-old Dinesh, was sent to work in a farm adjoining the prison along with 45 other inmates. Ten guards were assigned to keep a watch over them. An official of the jail informed that the guards were distracted while on duty which led to this embarrassing incident for the UP police

Suspect with Pak terror links held

A man suspected of having links with a Pakistan-based terror organisation was arrested in this district, police said on Wednesday. The accused, identified as Suhail (20), is a native of Uttar Pradesh, they said. He had recently arrived in Harihar taluk, where he was working as a painter, police added. The accused was picked up on Tuesday in a joint operation with intelligence officials following inputs from the National Investigation Agency.

"We secured the accused and handed him over to the investigating agency concerned," a senior police officer said, without divulging further details.

According to police, suspected terror-related material was found on his WhatsApp account, and he was allegedly in contact with several persons based in Pakistan.

The arrest comes weeks after two men were arrested from Tumakuru and Davangere districts on June 4 for allegedly maintaining contact through social media with a Pakistan-based individual and conspiring to carry out activities prejudicial to India's national security.

Confirming the arrest, Karnataka Home Minister Priyank Kharge said a Uttar Pradesh native arrested was found to have been in contact with some Pakistanis. The minister underlined further details would emerge only after the investigation is completed.

Kharge said preliminary findings indicated that the individual had come to Karnataka in search of work and that investigators had recovered information from his mobile phone, leading to his arrest.

"According to the preliminary investigation and the information available, that person from Uttar Pradesh had apparently come here in search of work. Some information has been detected from his mobile phone. So he's been arrested," Kharge told reporters.
