

Washington: The Justice Department said on Tuesday it had disrupted a long-running Russian cyberespionage campaign that stole sensitive information from computer networks in dozens of countries, including the US and other NATO members.

Protests erupt over Imran's arrest

The arrest of ex-Prime Minister of Pakistan, Imran Khan on Tuesday outside the Islamabad High Court (IHC) resulted in protests and demonstrations by Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) supporters across Pakistan.

PTI workers protested in Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Karachi, Gujranwala, Faisalabad, Multan, Peshawar, and Mardan, reported Geo News.

Meanwhile, the police imposed prohibitory orders in Islamabad after several workers of the PTI staged protests across the city and created a riot-like situation following the arrest of Khan.

In Karachi, demonstrators clashed with the police near Nursery. They threw stones at police vehicles and tore down street lights.

Police also fired teargas shells at protesters on Rawalpindi's Murree Road.

The PTI supporters were seen chanting "Release Imran Khan," and "Shut down Pakistan," in the streets of Lahore, Faizabad, Bannu, and Peshawar.

Imran Khan's party Twitter handle urged Pakistanis to come out and protest against his arrest.

"Pakistan, its your time now. It's now or never an opportunity. People must come out to defend their country now," it tweeted.

Khan faces over 120 cases in different cities

Pakistan's former prime minister Imran Khan is facing 121 cases across the country, including for committing treason and blasphemy and inciting violence and terrorism.

The Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) party led by Khan recently submitted a list of cases to the Islamabad High Court. The list states that 31 cases have been registered against Khan in the federal capital and 30 and call-up notices have been issued in Lahore, the capital of Punjab province.

These cases are related to various charges like treason, blasphemy, committing and inciting violence and terrorism. According to the list, 12 cases of terrorism have been registered against Imran in Lahore and 14 cases have been registered in Faisalabad. Some 22 terrorism cases have been registered against Imran Khan across the country.

Real war unleashed on Russia: Putin

Russian President Vladimir Putin on Tuesday told his country's Victory Day parade in Moscow's Red Square that "a real war" has been unleashed against Russia by the West's "untamed ambitions," shortly after the Kremlin's forces rained cruise missiles on Ukrainian targets.

"Today civilisation is once again at a decisive turning point," Putin said at Moscow's annual commemorations celebrating the defeat of Nazi Germany in World War II. "A real war has been unleashed against our Motherland." Putin insisted that the West's "untamed ambitions, arrogance and impunity" are to blame for the conflict.

Putin welcomed soldiers fighting in Ukraine who were present at the parade. "To Russia! To our brave armed forces! To Victory!" Putin concluded the speech.

Russia unleashed a barrage of cruise missiles on Ukraine overnight into Tuesday, hours before the start of the Moscow parade.

The Kremlin's forces launched 25 missiles in a wave of attacks across Ukraine, the Ukrainian air force said, adding that air defence had successfully destroyed 23 of them.

In a Telegram post, the air

force said eight Kalibr cruise missiles were launched from carriers in the Black Sea toward the east and 17 from strategic aircraft.

The barrage came as Moscow and other cities hosted military parades and other festivities that this year has been significantly overshadowed by war in Ukraine.

At least 21 Russian cities cancelled military parades - the staple of celebrations across Russia for the first time in years. The Immortal Regiment processions, in which crowd take to streets holding portraits of relatives who died or served in World War II - another pillar of the holiday - have also

been canceled in multiple cities. Regional officials blamed unspecified "security concerns." Some speculated, that the reason behind canceling Immortal Regiment marches was that Russians might bring portraits of relatives who died in Ukraine to those processions, illustrating the scale of Russia's losses in the drawn-out conflict.

Initially, only Kyrgyz President Sadyr Zhaparov was expected to attend, but at the last minute, officials confirmed that leaders of Armenia, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan were heading to Moscow as well.

China raids offices of biz consultancy Capvison

China's chief foreign intelligence agency has raided the offices of business consulting firm Capvison in Beijing and other Chinese cities as part of an ongoing crackdown on foreign businesses that provide sensitive economic data.

Foreign companies operating in China have come under increasing pressure, driven by national security considerations, as the government tightens control over business, clashing with efforts to lure back foreign investors after the pandemic restrictions were lifted.

Investigators simultaneously visited Capvison branches in Beijing, Shanghai, and the southeastern manufacturing hubs of Suzhou and Shenzhen, along with other locations the state media reports did not identify.

Officers from the Ministry of State Security, police and market regulatory bodies questioned staff, the reports said. There was no word on arrests or detentions, although reports said investigations had been opened into the company and "personal involved in the case according to law."

No details were given about legal issues at stake, and state media did not give the exact dates of the raids on Capvison, which is headquartered in New York and Shanghai.

Israeli airstrikes in Gaza kill 13

Israel killed three senior commanders of the militant Islamic Jihad group in targeted airstrikes on Tuesday, the military said. Palestinian health officials said 13 people were killed in all, including the commanders, their wives, several of their children and others nearby.

The attacks in densely pop-

ulated residential areas hit the top floor of an apartment building in Gaza City and a house in the town of Rafah. The Palestinian Health Ministry said 20 people were wounded, and ambulances were evacuating people from the targeted areas.

Airstrikes continued on Tuesday, targeting militant training sites, Israel said.

In the past, Palestinian mil-

itant groups in Gaza were retaliated for targeted killings. In anticipation of Palestinian rocket attacks in response to airstrikes, the Israeli military advised residents of communities within 40 kilometres of Gaza to stay close to designated bomb shelters.

Israel ordered closure of schools, beaches and highways in southern Israel, and limited public gatherings.
