Excess students at SSC centres put schools in a fix

espite the dwindling registrations overall in Maharashtra for the SSC board 2022-23, the number of students enrolling from Mumbai has not seen a sharp change with some schools even reporting a surplus of students. A total of 3.54 lakh students are to appear from the Mumbai division, which includes Mumcentre in suburban Mumbai. bai city, Thane, Palghar, and Raigad. At 1.16 lakh, the highest number of students hailed from Thane while the

Mumbai at 30,850. Some schools hosting exams in the city have reported an increased influx of students than in previous years. "Our school will be going online for classes 1-9 till the boards come to an end. We have seen a rise in students assigned to us and we need to accommodate all of them. Even after this the board for asking us to take in 50 more children but we just couldn't," said Poonam Arora, Principal of Bombay Cambridge International School in Andheri

The same dilemma was faced by another convent school in Bandra, where the school of 18 classrooms was asked to accommodate 400 students. The auditorium was turned into a classroom to hold all the students.

"There are many large schools around us that have been assigned very few students. Today we hosted very few students for the Urdu language paper, a large crowd is expected tomorrow," said the principal of the Bandra school.

To ensure that those appearing for exams are not distracted, lectures are held only during those hours when board examinations

are not being conducted. In the space-crunched city of Mumbai, only those with large campuses are able to smoothly manage both. "We have seen a rise of almost 5% in the number of students as signed to our school. Fortunately, we have enough class es to accommodate them but many schools have had to go online to conduct lectures for classes 1 to 9," said a Principal of a Deputy SSC exam

To many it seems that the Maharashtra Board has thrown in the towel after assigning schools to students. providing no assistance to institutions in need. "After years of having only 700-750 students, the board has suddenly sent 1000 SSC and 533 HSC students our way," said Sudhir Ghagas, Principal of Padmashri Annasaheb Jadhav School in Bhiwandi.

With the timetables of the two exams colliding, the principal had to rent 20 rooms from the neighbouring BNN College to accommodate all the students. "The board has asked us to solve logistical problems at our own level. We have resorted to calling classes 1 to 4 and classes 5 to 9 on alternate days," he added. While some speculate that

this increase is intended to compensate for the closure of vernacular schools during the pandemic, board members state that the number of students assigned to each centre is proportional to their admissions. "These schools may have upped their intake in the past few years," said Anuradha Oak, Secretary of the Maharashtra State Board.

Beginning with the First Language Paper, Maharashtra Board's Class 10 SSC exams commenced on Thurs-



Only 4 textbooks per class!

Govt to club books, include writing pages for note-taking

MUSAB QAZI / MUMBAI

n order to reduce the weight of school bags, the state government has decided to club the textbooks of all the subjects of a particular class into a mere four books, while inserting in them additional pages for note-taking.

The new textbooks, which

will be introduced in the upcoming academic year 2023-24, will be made available to students at government and private-aided schools on an experimental basis. Students at private unaided schools will continue to get the existing books until stocks run out, after which they will also get the new "integrated" textbooks, albeit without the

writing pages.

According to a government resolution (GR) issued on Tuesday, the changes were recommended by experts to lighten the book load and to provide writing space to rural students who are often deprived of necessary stationery. However, the new books are likely to be cost-

lier due to additional pages and rising cost of paper.

There will be two pages for note-taking after each chapter in the new books for class es 3 to 10, while the books for class 1 and 2 students will have more space for writing Class 9 and 10 students will continue to have separate textbooks for optional sub

State identifies land parcels for 11 new medical colleges

Each college to have 100 intake capacity, 430 beds in attached hospital

he state government may soon start work on setting up 11 new medical colleges and hospitals, which have been announced by Medical Education Minister Girish Maha-

The state directorate of medical education and research (DMER) has submitted a detailed proposal to the government for constructing colleges at 11 places in the state that lack adequate healthcare facilities. According to the proposal, which will likely be taken up by the state cabinet for approval in the days to come, each college will have an intake capacity of 100 students, while the attached hospitals will have 430 beds each.

The state currently has 57 medical colleges with a cumulative intake capacity of around 9,000.

The directorate has also identified various plots of land in Ambernath, Palghar, Gadchiroli, Amravati, Hingoli, Washim, Jalna, Buldhana, Ahmednagar, Bhandara and Wardha that can be made available for college buildings. The cost of entire project. including construction, equipment and salaries to be paid to hospital officials and employees, has been estimated to be Rs 5335.88 crore.

"The proposal will be sent for the cabinet's approval within next couple of weeks," said Dr Ashwini Joshi, Secretary, Medical Education and Drugs Department.

Last year, the government had announced setting up medical colleges in 12 districts that don't have even a single college. The state will take a loan of Rs 4,000 crore from the Asian

The move is aimed at the state's abysmal doctor-to-resident ratio, which stands at 0.64:1000, much lower than the minimum four doctors per 1000 residents benchmark set by the World Health Organisation (WHO). According to DMER, around 30 to 40% positions in the state's public health facilities are lying vacant, which re-

sults in poor healthcare access in the state's rural, semi-urban and remote

Most of the land spotted for new medical colleges is under the control of either district collectorates or the state's various departments including revenue, forest and animal husbandry. In Gadchiroli and Amravati districts, the directorate has proposed to make necessary changes in under construction nursing colleges to also use them temporarily for medical col-

In order to meet the norms set by the National Medical Commission (NMC), DMER has also proposed to temporarily transfer the control of land, district hospitals and their facilities from public health departments of district administration to the state's medical education department until the construction of new col-

The construction cost of each college has been pegged at Rs 216.75 crore. The directorate has also suggested creating 448 new posts of employees for each college, which is estimated to cost the state Rs 34.7 crore over a period of four years. On the other hand, the attached hospitals will each need 986 employees, whose salaries will add up to Rs 42.9 crore
