

# Explosives used without intimation ahead of Yogi's Bahraich visit, BJP MLA says 'serious security lapse'

**Bahraich:** Two days ahead of Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath's proposed visit to Bahraich, a company authorised by the Union Petroleum Ministry allegedly used a large quantity of explosives for drilling without informing the local administration, officials said.

Local BJP MLA Surveshvar Singh termed the incident a "serious security lapse" and demanded cancellation of the chief minister's visit.

Sub-Divisional Magistrate Alok Prasad told PTI that AlphaGeo India Limited was assigned the task of drilling and surveying for oil and gas deposits by the Petroleum Ministry. The firm was using ammonium nitrate explosives for the survey.

Though the company was carrying out government-sanctioned work, it failed to follow the standard operating



procedures (SOP) and did not inform the local administration, he said.

This caused panic among villagers and resentment among the public representatives. Upon receiving information, police and administrative staff reached the site and initiated an inquiry, the SDM added.

He said that around 200 employees of the company were working in different shifts across

multiple villages, most of whom are from West Bengal and face a language barrier with the locals.

To ensure their safety amid growing tension, all employees were brought to the Hardi police station, he added.

Additional Superintendent of Police (Rural) Durga Prasad Tiwari said the company had drilled up to 30 metres underground using ammonium nitrate without prior intimation to villagers or authorities.

"Today, around 50-60 employees deployed on the field were called to the police station for questioning. No one has been detained so far. The decision on filing an FIR will be taken after further inquiry," he said.

Raising alarm, Mahsi MLA Sureshvar Singh said with the chief minister scheduled to visit on Tuesday, the presence of hundreds of outsiders and 500 kilograms of explosives in the district is highly concerning.

Intelligence reports have warned of possible infiltration by 47 terrorists through the Indo-Nepal border. Imagine the security risk at an event where the chief minister and possibly the Prime Minister will be present, commemorating Maharaja Suheldev, he said.

He added that he had spoken to the state's Principal Secretary (Home) Sanjay Prasad and urged him to cancel the chief minister's visit until the matter is fully resolved.

Kuldeep Sharma, a representative of AlphaGeo India Limited, admitted to the lapse.

"We had informed the concerned authorities back in February. However, we should have informed them again before commencing work involving explosives. Since today was Sunday, we proceeded without intimation, which was a mistake," he said.

## Adityanath 'lacks courage' to face farmers on ground: Akhilesh Yadav

**Lucknow:** Samajwadi Party president Akhilesh Yadav on Monday criticised Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath for conducting an aerial survey of crops, saying he "lacked the courage" to confront angry farmers on the ground. Adityanath had carried out an aerial survey of maize crop on Sunday.

In a post on X, Yadav took a swipe at Adityanath's survey, saying it was not time constraints but fear of public anger that kept him away from meeting farmers directly.

The former chief minister did not name anyone in the post but posted a news report of the survey.

"Those doing aerial surveys for agriculture are not short of time, but short of the 'courage' required to face the farmers' anger on the ground," Yadav wrote in Hindi.



He further questioned the effectiveness of such surveys, asking whether stray cattle -- a major issue for farmers in the state -- can even be seen from such heights.

"Farmers are asking, can stray animals be seen from such an altitude?" he posted.

The remarks come amid growing complaints from farmers about crop damage due to unseasonal rains and the menace of stray cattle, an issue that has remained a concern in rural Uttar Pradesh.

## Systematic urban mapping to begin in ten cities of state to resolve land disputes

**Lucknow:** In a significant move to modernize urban land records and curb land-related disputes, a comprehensive mapping initiative will soon be launched across ten urban bodies in Uttar Pradesh. Speaking at the Ambedkar Auditorium of the Revenue Council, Manoj Joshi, Secretary of the Land Resources Department under the Union Ministry of Rural Development, highlighted that current maps of urban areas in the state are outdated and were primarily created for tax purposes. As cities have expanded, the need for updated and precise mapping has become urgent. Joshi announced that under this new mapping initiative, the Central Government will provide ₹192 crore to Uttar Pradesh, while a broader incentive package of ₹10,000 crore is being extended to states



across the country. The programme aims to resolve land disputes by generating systematic maps using drone technology, bringing greater clarity and transparency to urban land records. The ten selected urban bodies for this pilot initiative include Tanda (Ambedkarnagar), Nawabganj (Barabanki), Anupshahar (Bulandshahr), Chitrakootdham (Chitrakoot), Gorakhpur, Hardoi, Jhansi, Chunar (Mirzapur), Pilibhit, and Shahjahanpur.

## Three killed, Three injured in tragic road accident on Lucknow-Sitapur highway

**Shahjahanpur:**

In a devastating road accident early Monday morning, three residents of Gorakhpur lost their lives, and three others sustained serious injuries after their car rammmed into a stationary truck on the Lucknow-Sitapur highway near Jamuka village under the jurisdiction of Roza police station.

The incident occurred around 6:00 am when a group of tourists was en route to Nainital. According to Inspector-in-Charge Rajiv Kumar, the vehicle collided with a



parked truck, resulting in severe damage and multiple casualties. The victims were immediately rushed to the Government Medical College for emergency treatment.

Among the deceased are Shivam Pandey (37), his two-

year-old son Madhavan Pandey, and Shweta Dwivedi (42). Shivam's wife, Shalini Pandey (27), Shweta's son Angad (22), and another individual sustained serious injuries and are currently undergoing treatment.

## 50 delegates from 5 ASEAN countries participated in six-day 'Bodhi yatra'

**Lucknow:** In a bid to place Uttar Pradesh's Buddhist heritage on the world map, the Yogi Adityanath-led government organised a special six-day "Bodhi Yatra", which saw the participation of 50 delegates from five ASEAN countries.

As part of this mission, the Uttar Pradesh Tourism Department, in association with the Union Ministry of External Affairs, organised the "Bodhi Yatra" under the Mekong-Ganga Cooperation (MGC) framework, an official statement said on Sunday.

The yatra, held from June 2 to June 7, aimed to showcase key destinations within the state's Buddhist circuit.

A 50-member delegation from five ASEAN nations -- Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, and Vietnam -- participated in the tour. The group included Buddhist monks, travel agents, and social media influencers.
