Explosives used without intimation ahead of Yogi's Bahraich visit, BJP MLA says 'serious security lapse'

Bahraich: Two days ahead of Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath's proposed visit to Bahraich, a company authorised by the Union Petroleum Ministry allegedly used a large quantity of explosives for drilling without the informing local administration, officials said.

Local BJP MLA Surveshvar Singh termed the incident a "serious security lapse" and demanded cancellation of the chief minister's visit.

Sub-Divisional Magistrate Alok Prasad told PTI that AlphaGeo India Limited was assigned the task of drilling and surveying for oil and gas deposits by the Petroleum Ministry. The firm was using ammonium nitrate explosives for the survey.

Though the company was carrying out governmentsanctioned work, it failed to follow the standard operating



procedures (SOP) and did not inform the local administration,

This caused panic among villagers and resentment among the public representatives. Upon receiving information, police and administrative staff reached the site and initiated an inquiry, the SDM added.

He said that around 200 employees of the company were working in different shifts across

multiple villages, most of whom are from West Bengal and face a language barrier with the locals.

To ensure their safety amid growing tension, all employees were brought to the Hardi police station, he added.

Additional Superintendent of Police (Rural) Durga Prasad Tiwari said the company had drilled up to 30 metres underground using ammonium nitrate without prior intimation to villagers or authorities.

"Today, around 50-60 employees deployed on the field were called to the police station for questioning. No one has been detained so far. The decision on filing an FIR will be taken after further inquiry," he said.

Raising alarm, Mahsi MLA Sureshvar Singh said with the chief minister scheduled to visit on Tuesday, the presence of hundreds of outsiders and 500 kilograms of explosives in the district is highly concerning.

Systematic urban mapping to begin in ten cities of state to resolve land disputes

Lucknow: In a significant move to modernize urban land records and curb land-related disputes, a comprehensive mapping initiative will soon be launched across ten urban bodies in Uttar Pradesh. Speaking at the Ambedkar Auditorium of the Revenue Council, Manoj Joshi, Secretary of the Land Resources Department under the Ministry Development, highlighted that current maps of urban areas in the state are outdated and were primarily created for tax purposes. As cities have expanded, the need for updated and precise mapping has become urgent. Joshi announced that under this new mapping initiative, the Central Government will provide ?192 crore to Uttar Pradesh, while a broader incentive package of ?10,000 crore is being extended to states



across the country. The programme aims to resolve land disputes by generating systematic maps using drone technology, bringing greater clarity and transparency to urban land records.
