The development comes on the back of the Supreme Court's recent ruling over the TET, where it made mandatory, not just for fresh appointees but also for the in-serers' Eligibility Test (TET) within two years.

TET came into force in 2011. According to the Apex Court's order, lakhs of teachers working in government, aided, and private schools will have to pass the test to stay in their position, and any failure to comply will lead to their compulsory retirement with terminal

Though the relaxation from mandatory TET was given to teachers with less than five years of service left; however, for job promotions, they will have to clear the compulsory test.

Saharanpur (The Hawk): The supply department has imposed a ban on ration distribution to individuals who have not completed their e-KYC (electronic Know Your Customer) process. Those who haven't done their e-KYC will have their ration suspended for

According to the supply department, around 1.25 lakh beneficiaries still need to complete their e-KYC out of a total of approximately 24.25 lakh people (23 lakh already completed). The department has taken this step to ensure transparency and smooth management in ration distribution.

The department declaired that ration will only be issued after the e-KYC process is completed, and those who haven't done it yet will have to wait. The administration has warned that ration will not be available without e-KYC.
