



Gill set to be named Cricketer of the Year at BCCI awards

India's Test and ODI captain Shubman Gill is set to be named Cricketer of the Year at the BCCI's annual awards to be held here on March 15. The 26-year-old, who was not picked in the T20 side that defended the World Cup crown last month, enjoyed a stellar run in the other two formats. He amassed 983 runs in Tests, including a whopping 754 in the drawn away series against England in 2025, at an average of over 70. His ODI runs tally stood at



490, including 188 runs during India's title-winning Champions Trophy campaign. Overall, Gill accumulated 1,764 runs across formats at an average of 49, dotted with seven centuries and three fifties. Although his T20

International form was not particularly impressive, he was in tremendous form during the IPL, scoring 650 runs for Gujarat Titans at an average of 50. Former India head coach Rahul Dravid is set to be honoured with the Col CK Nayudu Lifetime Achievement Award for his monumental contribution to Indian cricket, including guiding the team to the 2024 T20 World Cup title. The Mumbai Cricket Association (MCA) is set to be named the Best Association in domestic cricket.

Always wanted to do a tough job: Bumrah

India's pace spearhead Jasprit Bumrah said he relishes taking responsibility in pressure situations and described the T20 World Cup defence as one of the most fulfilling of his career.



Bumrah played a stellar role claiming four wickets as India handed New Zealand a crushing 96-run defeat in the final to become the only team to win the T20 World Cup three times. "I don't want to hide behind, I want to be in the thick of things. I always wanted to do a tough job," Bumrah, who was adjudged the Player of the Match, said in a video shared by BCCI after the victory. "I've played cricket for that. I started cricket for that. When I'm able to make a difference, that gives me so much joy. No better feeling than that." For the Gujarat-born pacer, the triumph carried added emotional significance as it came at the venue where his cricket journey began. "I started my cricket here."

Final batch of SA, WI players leave India

The last batch of South African and West Indian players stranded in India after the T20 World Cup departed, the ICC announced on Thursday, ending a crisis caused by the closure of Gulf airspace in the wake of the raging West Asia conflict. The ongoing war threw travel plans into disarray, leaving the South African and West Indies teams stranded in Kolkata due to closure of airspace and airports at major transit points like Dubai. The West Indies and South Africa stars Quinton de Kock and David Miller, who insinuated that England players were given better travel arrangements as they were able to leave within a day of their semifinal exit. Earlier, West Indies head coach Daren Sammy had also expressed frustration at the lack of updates from the governing body after a charter flight scheduled to depart from Kolkata was cancelled due to their respective homelands, bringing to a close a complex operation that has taken place under exceptionally challenging global travel conditions,"

the ICC said. The ICC added that ensuring the "safe onwards travel for all players and staff was the sole aim", which required constant adjustments as conditions evolved. "Throughout this period, the ICC's operations and logistics teams have worked continuously with governments, airlines, charter providers, airport authorities and our member boards to navigate a number of operational disruptions caused by the evolving environment." The ICC had earlier drawn criticism from former England captain Michael Vaughan and South African stars Quinton de Kock and David Miller, who insinuated that England players were given better travel arrangements as they were able to leave within a day of their semifinal exit. Earlier, West Indies head coach Daren Sammy had also expressed frustration at the lack of updates from the governing body after a charter flight scheduled to depart from Kolkata was cancelled due to their respective homelands, bringing to a close a complex operation that has taken place under exceptionally challenging global travel conditions,"

Bim10: ICC suspends player, two top officials on corruption charges

The ICC has provisionally suspended fast-bowling all-rounder Javon Searles and two people linked to a franchise for multiple breaches of the apex body's anti-corruption codes during the 2023-24 Bim10 tournament in Barbados. Besides Searles, the ICC has suspended Titans team owner Chitransh Rathod and team official Trevon Griffith from all cricket. Bim10 was a fast-paced 10-over-per-innings tournament that featured six teams -- Voyagers, Guardians, Titans, Settlers,

Warriors, and Pelicans. The tournament, which was last held in 2023-24, falls under the jurisdiction of the Cricket West Indies (CWI) anti-corruption code, and the charges were brought by the ICC and CWI under their respective anti-corruption codes. The trio have 14 days from March 11, 2026, to respond to the charges, the ICC said. The charges involve match-fixing, soliciting players, and failing to report corrupt approaches to the anti-corruption officials. Searles, who has represented West Indies Under-19s, played for Trinbago Knight Riders in the CPL, and also featured in the IPL for Kolkata Knight Riders in 2018, faces four charges under the CWI anti-corruption code. Rathod has been charged with facilitating corruption within his franchise, and Griffith also faces four charges under the CWI code and one under the ICC code, including allegedly obstructing the investigation by tampering with information. These charges are part of a larger, ongoing investigation into the 2023-24 edition of the tournament, which also previously involved suspended USA batter Aaron Jones being charged with five breaches.

BHAMBRI ENTERS MAIDEN ATP MASTERS 1000 SEMIFINAL

India's Yuki Bhambri entered his maiden ATP Masters 1000 semifinal as he and his Swedish partner Andre Goransson defeated Alexander Erler and Andrea Vavassori in straight sets in Indian Wells here.

The 33-year-old Indian had previously reached the doubles quarter-finals at the Masters 1000 level twice, including at Indian Wells last year. Bhambri and Goransson defeated the Austrian-Italian pair 6-3 7-6 in the quarterfinals that lasted over one hour 30 minutes. The Indo-Swedish duo dominated on their first serve, winning 83 per cent of the points (29/35), which proved crucial in taking the second-set tie-break and closing out the match. They will take on France's Arthur Rinderknech and Monaco's Valentin Vacherot in the semifinals on Friday. Rinderknech and Vacherot defeated the Russian duo of Andrey Rublev and Karen Khachanov 6-3 6-4 in their quarterfinal.

Aston Villa to face Lille in Europa League

Aston Villa travelled to Lille to kick off the Europa League round of 16 on Thursday boosted by the return from injury of captain John McGinn. McGinn was absent for seven weeks since a knee injury in a Premier League loss to Everton in January. "It's massive to have him back," teammate Morgan Rogers said. "He puts a smile on people's faces, he plays



with that smile, wears the badge on his sleeve and he brings a lot to our team." Villa and Lille also met in the Conference League

quarterfinals two years ago, when Unai Emery's men advanced on penalties. Another English side, Nottingham Forest, needs to put relegation worries aside when it hosts Danish club Midtjylland. In an all-Italia derby, Bologna hosts Roma. The Europa League format launched last season - 36 teams in a single-standings league format then a tennis-style knockout bracket - lets teams from the same country meet at any point in the knockout phase.

Lisa disappointed at lack of female coaches in women's Hundred

Former Australian cricketer Lisa Keightley is "disappointed" at the lack of female head coaches in the women's Hundred and hopes more will join her in the future. Keightley, who is at the helm of MI London, was the only woman head coach among the eight teams at Wednesday's historic player auction. There has been a significant increase in player salaries, with a total of 178 cricketers going under the hammer at the auction. "It's really changing fast,



isn't it? And I suppose the three powerhouses - India, England, and Australia - having very competitive T20 competitions is really driving the women's space and the pay equity," she told "ESPNCricinfo". "We're not there, but it's moving and it's moving pretty fast, so that's really good." "The only thing I'm disappointed in is I look around the room, and I'm the only female

head coach. So for me, waving the flag, and hopefully as we move into cricket, we get a few more female head coaches here," she added. The League will start on July 21 and conclude on August 16.
